Leadership in Education

Dr. Capolupo is currently the Founder and President of Capbridge Solutions, an executive coaching company. He is currently on the faculty at Villanova in the education department. Dr. Capolupo serves on the Board of Trustees at the Pennsylvania Institute of Technology He is also is a member of the President's Advisory Group at the Malvern Retreat House. Dr. Capolupo spent the two years helping Charter schools. First, as the CEO of Lindley Academy in Philadelphia, then as President of the high performing Charter School of Wilmington. Prior to that, he served as Associate Dean of the College of Education and Social Work at West Chester University. He was the Superintendent of the Springfield School District in Springfield, Delaware County, Pennsylvania. He was awarded the 2014 National Superintendent of the Year by the National Association of School Superintendents. In addition, he was awarded the 2015 Pennsylvania Superintendent of the Year Award by the Pennsylvania Association of School Administrators. Prior to becoming the Superintendent, he held the position of Director of Teaching and Learning, also in Springfield. Dr. Capolupo's background in education began as an elementary, middle school and high school band director. His first administrative post was a Coordinator of Fine Arts. He also was an Assistant Principal, Acting Principal and Principal. In addition, he was a Director of Elementary Education and Director of Teaching and Learning.

Dr. Capolupo has also taught at Cabrini College, Neumann University, Arcadia University, Chestnut Hill College, Lincoln University and Princeton University. He is currently working at Villanova University as well as serving as an Executive Coach for School Districts, School Boards and Administrators.

His academic preparation includes a B.S. in Music Education; M.A. in Education, Certificate of Advanced Study in Education, D.M.A. in Music and post-doctoral work in Educational Leadership. He also received an Honorary D.H.L. from Cabrini College where he was recently commencement speaker for the Graduate Division. In December 2014, Dr. Capolupo served as the commencement speaker at West Chester University. His most recent academic study has been at the University of Pennsylvania (Post-Doctorate) and Harvard University (Executive Leadership Coaching). He is certified as a Superintendent in New Jersey and Pennsylvania.

Dr. Capolupo served on the Board of Governors of the Pennsylvania Association of School Administrators where he served as the Membership Chair. He was also on the Professional Development Committee and the Resolutions Committee. Dr. Capolupo was elected to be Chairman of the Board for the National Association of School Superintendents.

He has presented various workshops at: Villanova University; University of Pennsylvania; Pennsylvania Title 1 Conference in Pittsburgh; Superintendents and Principals in the 21st Century in New England; International Reading Conference in Atlanta; Pennsylvania Counselors State Conference; Pennsylvania Music Educators Conference and at the NSBA conference in New Orleans, Denver and Boston as well at the AASA National Conference in San Diego and New Orleans on the Topic of Elementary Literacy and also on Leadership. Additionally, he has presented at the U.S. Department of Education in Washington on three occasions. He is co-author of the 2015 book, "Behind the Curtain: Tackling the Myths and Mysteries of School Management" He has presented at the National Association of School Superintendents in San Diego and the PSBA/PSBA Conference in Harrisburg. Dr. Capolupo has given School Board Retreats in school districts in America and in Costa Rica and Belize. Additionally, he has presented workshops to teachers and principals in Belize.

Dr. Capolupo has received the Robert Flynn Distinguished Service Award from the Pennsylvania Association of Supervision and Curriculum Development.
